## ENGLISH OAK (Quercus robur)

## ALL ABOUT THE ENGLISH OAK

- Oak is one of the hardest woods and is used in many different ways including building, flooring and wine barrels!
- Oak leaves are around 10 cm long and have wavy, lobed edges. Oak trees are deciduous so they lose their leaves in the autumn and they regrow again in spring.
- The bark of an oak tree is dark grey with deep furrows in it.
- The fruit of the oak tree is an acorn they are around 2 cm long and they sit in cups on the tree. They are green when they are young, before turning brown as they ripen and they provide food for many animals.
- Oak trees can live up to 1,000 years, and produce up to 10,000 acorns a year.


## HOW BIG IS IT?

The English oak can grow up to 40 metres tall, and around 15 to 25 metres wide.
